

LIBRARY COVID-19 GUIDELINES

- Stay at home if you are sick or have a fever.
- Masks or face coverings are required.
- Please use hand sanitizers provided before entering the library.
- No more than 10 people in the library at any given time.
- The library will not be a gathering place for groups during the pandemic or have seating available for more than 2 persons per table.
- All returned materials will be sanitized and quarantined for 24 hours before they are available on the shelf.
- Only 3 public computers are available in order to accommodate social distancing.
- Each computer session will be limited to a 45 minute session, per patron per day (15 minutes for social networking). At the end of each session, staff will sanitize the computer and surrounding area.
- Please limit your library time to 15 minutes.
- All children (10 and under) must be accompanied by an adult while in the building.
- No in-library activities. Makerspace will not be available.
- No private party reservations for the meeting room until further notice.
- No homebound services until further notice.
